"Fundy Home Educators coordinated the Regional Heritage Fair for the private and home schools in the province. The event was held in Saint John on May 4, 2018. Each school/home school had their own local fair and then chose their top projects to participate at the Regional level. The event was sponsored by the N.B. departments of

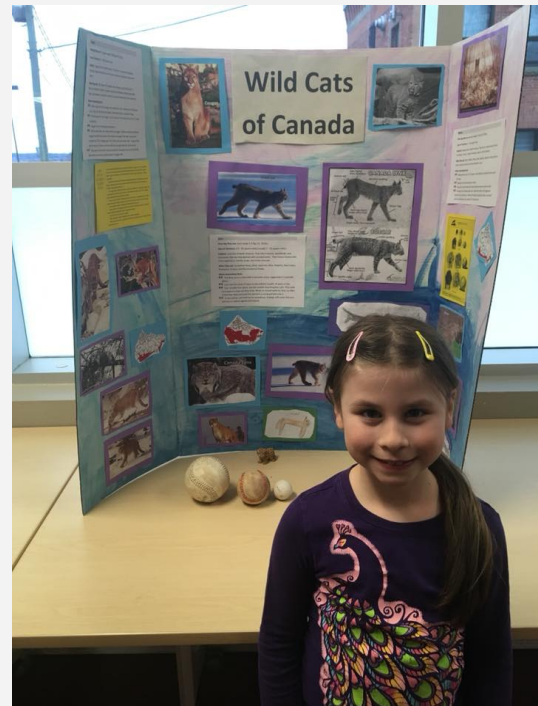
Heritage Education, Heritage Branch, Tourism, Heritage and Culture.

Forty-six projects in total were chosen to represent their school/homeschool. There were 14 students from Fundy Home Educators, 2 students from Greater Fredericton

Home Educators, 4 from Heritage Valley Home Educators and 9 from Moncton Christian Home Educators. The remaining projects were from 3 private schools within the province. A representative from Archives New Brunswick did a workshop with the students. Fair coordinators were Emilie Matheson (past 14 year homeschooler) and

Jillian Ramsay (7 year homeschooler and Fundy Home Educator's leader). A representative from the province stated that the quality of the fair and the projects was very high."

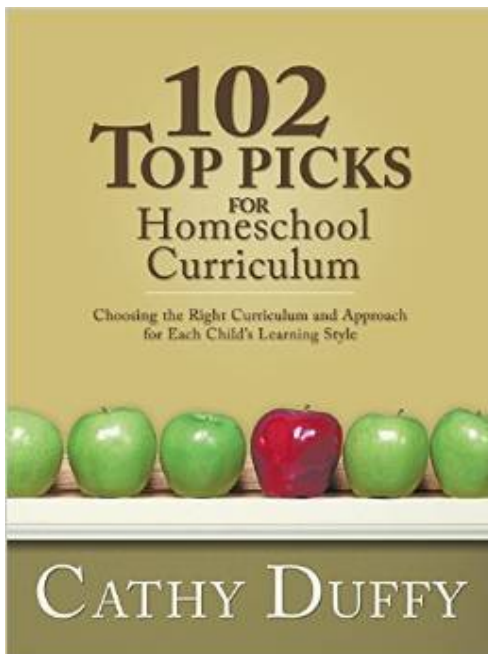
